1. ANNUAL AFFILIATION

R225-00 per annum per student. **(Cash Only)** This amount is payable with your first payment of the year each year. Students may **NOT** participate in class, tournaments or grading unless affiliations are paid. Upon registering, you will receive a club affiliation booklet.

2. MONTHLY FEES

R200 per month. Fees are payable as in advance.
