### 1. ANNUAL AFFILIATION

**R225-00** per annum per student. **(Cash Only)** This amount is payable with your first payment of the year each year . Students may **NOT** participate in class, tournaments or grading unless affiliations are paid. Upon registering, you will receive a club affiliation booklet.

### 2. MONTHLY FEES

R250 per month. Fees are payable as in advance.

### 4. GRADINGS
